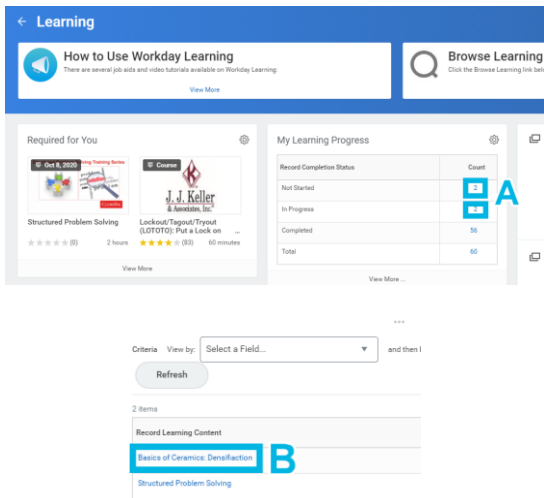
Things to Know:
