




Symptoms Check

It can be difficult to tell whether you have COVID-19 or influenza since the symptoms are similar. You shouldn't assume you have one or the other if you show symptoms such as a dry cough or fever. Consult with your doctor who may require both influenza and COVID-19 testing and provide guidance on how to minimize spread.
